IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Floats may not be more than 13'6" high.
- All floats must have **at least 2 walkers per axle** beside it along the entire parade route to ensure the safety and clearance of the float and spectators!
- Floats must be accompanied by walkers at each wheel when in motion.
- Children may not get on or off the float during the parade unless in case of emergency.
- ALL Floats must provide a representative to the pre-parade meeting held at the Hingham High School (Union Street Entrance).
