Committee Minutes March 6, 2019 – 11<sup>th</sup> Meeting

**Meeting Convened:**

Chair Carol Pyles called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm. Also in attendance from the CPC were: Vicki Donlan, Larry Lindner, Jim Watson and Dan White. Unable to attend: Kevin Burke, Jennifer Gay Smith, Bill Harrington and Robert Mosher. Attending from staff was Carol Costello. Advisory liaison in attendance: Tom Belyea.

**Announcements/Open Discussion:**

Carol Pyles reported that the Board of Selectmen voted unanimously in support of the CPC Warrant Article. On February 26<sup>th</sup>, the Advisory Committee voted favorably on the CPC Warrant Article with two members voting against the Plymouth River School Playground project funding. One of them reserved the right to speak against the recommended grant amount for this project at Annual Town Meeting.

**Approval of Minutes:**

**VOTE:** Larry Lindner made a motion to accept the minutes from the CPC's February 6, 2019, meeting, seconded by Jim Watson - all in favor: (5-0) - Vicki Donlan abstained

**Review Status of CPC grants:**

Chair Pyles reviewed with the committee all incomplete projects. There were two projects that were coming up to the two-year time limit: The Tower Clocks and Old Ship Steeple Restoration.

**Town Tower Clocks – ATM2017**

Carol Costello reported that Andrea Young stated that the clocks should be completed by June 30, 2019; however, if they are not on schedule, she will come before the CPC board at their April 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting to request an extension.

**Old Ship Steeple Restoration – ATM2017 for \$41K**

Proponent, Tom Willson reported that he is confident that their project will be completed by June 2019. They now have two other grants to help them with the work. Massachusetts Preservation Projects Fund (MPPF) for \$50K and Greenbush grant for \$18K. They also need to be completed by June 2019 to meet the requirements of the MPPF grant.
