Coops Troops

Jackie Kilrain responded to questions from the Committee on path of travel so that park visitors, other than runners, have access to the park. The race will begin on the opposite side of the triangle from the parking lot leaving access both to the left and right of the triangle. Race is July 21, 2019 expecting 300 runners.

Ed O'Connor, Cambridge 5K

Requesting access to the park on June 9, 2019. This 5 mile race attracts very fast runners. Event will take 1.5 hours, 1500 runners expected. Organization has hosted 4000 runners in Cambridge, donated \$200K to charity, is USA Track and Field Certified with 100-150 volunteers. Half the proceeds are donated to charity. Scott will let staff in on Sunday AM. The Hingham Shipyard who hosts a party afterwards supports this race. Proposal: Five mile race through Bare Cove from Shipyard ending at Lynch Field on Sunday June 9 from 10:30 am to noon for a donation of \$5000 to Friends of Bare Cove. Unanimously approved.
