

## **Bare Cove Park Committee Meeting Notes**

**Tuesday May 12 , 2020**

Guest: Art Collins

- Triangle Garden (Art Collins, Hingham Land Conservation Trust)
  - Art Collins provided update on the Triangle Garden
    - prepared area for perennials, with central tree to attract butterflies and bees for pollination
  - discussion on pollinator opportunities
  - Ted mentioned that Larry Courtney has volunteered to trim areas of the park
- Ranger's Report accepted (Scott McMillan)
  - May 4 porta-potties were dropped in 2 locations.
    - Soap dispensers, frequently stolen, cost \$25 to replace so were not installed
  - Repaired hole in roof at Dock House Museum
  - Bill for paint supplies for gate at Triangle Garden is \$129.92. Discussion and approval of \$100 gift for many of hours of work completed by Larry Courtney as an outstanding volunteer.
  - Activity in the park continues as BCP is only outdoor space open during COVID19 isolation. It is being used well, some use masks, plenty of bicycle use. Parking lot is managed well and trash barrels are being used.
- Treasurer's Report
  - Discussion about use of Porta potties in the park. Unanimous decision that porte-potties will be left through August and will re-evaluate then. Cost is \$600 for 3 month period.

- Signage
  - Leah discussed a sign about the size of a poster board to be placed on the gate entrances.
- CPC funds for renovating the Green Dock House Museum
  - ADA related. Leah suggested that a design and contractor was needed to complete an appraisal process prior to submission to CPC. She will assist Claudia in connecting with such person.
- Ted acknowledged that Fran Rockett is leaving the Committee as his 3 year term is up. Fran was lauded for his consistently fine work with the Committee.
