Meeting called to order at 7:05 pm

- Reviewed and Accepted April Meeting Minutes
- Ranger's Report (Scott McMillan) - Approved
 - Vacation last month. Dump/trash, patrolling. Trimming of edges of fields. Started mowing again.
 - Removed rat trap from waters edge (washed in from somewhere).
 - Filled water tank for crew team to wash salt water off of boats.
 - HHS baseball team cleanup at triangle garden.
 - On April 30th - Regatta. Museum open.
 - Several new signs up. Need a new post installed for final signs.
 - Museum was open Sunday the 8th - approximately 30 visitors.
 - New blades for plow ordered.
 - New flags ordered Feb 1, are already up. 1 set goes up around May 1st and the other around November.
- Treasurer's Report - Approved
 - Salary and porta-potty.
 - Will meet with Sue Nickerson to make sure numbers reconcile.
 - About 10k left. \$3500 earmarked for salary. Another \$550 for portapotty. Slightly over on fuel.
- Discussion of Movie Filming
 - Have not heard back from Vlogger
- Festival of lights discussion - voted not to pursue last meeting
- Memorial bench guidelines - tabled
- Open House Discussion
 - Father's day - June 19th from 11-3.
 - Have Wanderlust food truck and a beer truck booked.
 - Looking into Nona's
 - Chalk, bubbles, face painting

- Ted and Ray - access to generator if needed for beer truck
- Additional picnic tables? People can also bring blankets and chairs.
- Signs similar to election signs to advertise. Advertise on facebook, in the Anchor, fliers around town.
- Selectboard and police dept (Jeff Kilroy) greenlighted event
- Entertainment - music?

- Parking lot availability? Youth sports should be done by then.
- Approved - Motion to spend up to \$2000 on event

- Map - visualize where things are going. Rough outline of where food trucks and entertainment would be.
- Establish subgroup meeting schedule - tabled
- Further discussion on projects for the park and 2022 goals
- Signage
 - Waiting on new post for final sign installation.
- Items not anticipated on the Agenda. Public discussion
 - Rowing team update:
 - Regatta this weekend, went well. Porta potties placed at end of green dockhouse will be gone by May 25, 1 month rental for the regatta.
 - Shells leave the park 1st week of June. Fence will then be folded up and placed along treeline. Will be set back up in September for the fall program.
 - Fence location improved from last season.
 - Consideration - create a door at the other end of the dockhouse from the museum to create shelter for the rowing team in inclement weather. Inside, there is a door that would separate the area from the museum.
 - BCP location works for rowing 5 feet either side of high tide or about 3 hours either side of high tide.
 - Potential plastic dock system. 20K. Would involve Conservation group, National Park Services, MA Environmental Coastal group. Easy to set up and break down. No permanent pilings. Can run off the highest point so would be ADA accessible.
 - Signage to discourage people from tying up to dock.

- Ring camera (solar powered)?
- Solar power ring system for dock house area coverage as well?
- Eileen Shaw - have not heard back from Town re: insurance.
- Almshouse - spoke to the Town Clerk. Agreed that if they can do it over the summer when not as busy, will take care of it and not charge the \$10 per record.
