

***AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF HINGHAM, MA
AND COMCAST CABLE COMMUNICATIONS MANAGEMENT, LLC***

Whereas, this Agreement is between Comcast Cable Communications Management, LLC (“Comcast”) and the Board of Selectmen of Hingham (“the Issuing Authority”), in its role as statutory Issuing Authority, regarding the existing Institutional Network (the “I-Net”), as more fully delineated below; and

Whereas, representatives from Comcast and the Issuing Authority have been negotiating in good faith regarding the existing I-Net as described in the Cable Television License, dated August 14, 2009 (the 2009 Renewal License”); and

Whereas, this Agreement shall be effective concurrently with the execution of the Hingham Cable Television Renewal License, with an Effective Date of August 14, 2019 (the “2019 Renewal License”).

NOW THEREFORE, the Issuing Authority and Comcast mutually agree to completely resolve said I-Net issues as follows:

Article 1: Cable-Related Fund Payment

- (a) Comcast shall provide a one-time payment to the Town of Hingham in the amount of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) for the purpose of supporting the Town’s cable-related needs within ninety (90) days of the execution of the new Comcast Hingham Television Renewal License.
- (b) Comcast hereby agrees that it shall not pass through to the Issuing Authority, the Town of Hingham and/or Comcast’s Hingham subscribers the cost of said Sixty Thousand Dollar (\$60,000.00) payment referenced above.
- (c) Upon decommission of the I-Net, Comcast shall ensure that current maintenance costs for the I-Net shall be adjusted in accordance with applicable laws and/or regulations to reflect the decommissioning of the existing I-Net.

Article 2: Future Obligations

Comcast shall continue to operate, maintain and repair the existing I-Net until August 14, 2021 or such earlier date as the Town of Hingham informs Comcast, in writing, that the transition will occur (“Transition Date”). Subject to the provisions herein, the Issuing Authority agrees that after the Transition Date, Comcast shall have no further responsibility for operating or maintaining the existing I-Net and said I-Net may be decommissioned for any and all uses by the Town. Until the Transition Date, Comcast shall continue to operate and maintain the existing I-Net to provide the applications and services that are in use by the Town and/or its designee(s) as of the Effective Date of the 2019 Renewal License, in accordance with applicable FCC standards and taking into account the availability of replacement parts, if applicable.




