Master Plan Committee (MPC) Chairman, Gordon Carr called the meeting to order at 7:31 PM and welcomed the Committee. He read the following statement into the record "This meeting is being held remotely as an alternate means of public access pursuant to an Order issued by the Governor of Massachusetts dated March 12, 2020 Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law. The next meeting will be working through the consent agenda for recommendations that received more than 75% support by the committee in survey monkey. Mr. Carr then turned the meeting over to Judi Barrett to start working through the economic development material and the committee discussed the recommendations in depth.
