Master Plan Committee (MPC) Chairman, Gordon Carr called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM and welcomed the Committee. Mr. Carr noted that due to the squall that went through town several people are dealing with power outages and downed trees and may join the meeting in progress as possible.

Mr. Carr then turned the meeting over to Judi Barrett. The group discussed the next meeting date and the group set October 21, 2020 as the next meeting date for the MPC, and then the 28<sup>th</sup>.
