NOTICE TO UTILITIES

SUBJECT: Roads that fall under the 5-year moratorium – 2020-2025

Attached you will find a list of streets in the Town of Hingham that have been repaved or reconstructed since 2020.

As you know, that in accordance with the General By-Laws of the Town of Hingham, the regulations of the Public Works Superintendent entitled, "Street Excavations," on Page 7, 1st paragraph states "Street surface openings henceforth will be restricted for a period of AT LEAST five (5) years after a new permanent surface is laid, except in cases of extreme emergency." Since modern bituminous concrete surface materials remain in excellent condition for many years beyond the aforesaid period and since such openings are the greatest single contributor to pavement deterioration, utility companies and contractors will be strictly limited in their ability to excavate within the Town's Right-of-Way.

The Town would appreciate your cooperation in abiding by these regulations and discouraging any future request for underground utility connections on these roads.
