However, there is and can be no warranty or guarantee or certainty that efforts to correct unsafe conditions will prevent breakage or failure of a tree. Our recommendations should reduce the risk of tree failure, but they cannot eliminate such risk, especially in the event of a storm or any other act of God. Some hazardous conditions in the landscape are apparent while others require detailed inspection and evaluation. While a detailed inspection and evaluation should and normally does result in the detection of potentially hazardous conditions, there can be no guarantee or certainty that all hazardous conditions will be detected.

PERFORMANCE BY TREE TECH, INC.

Work crews will arrive at the job site unannounced unless otherwise noted herein. Tree Tech, Inc. shall attempt to meet all performance dates, but shall not be liable for damage due to delays for inclement weather or other causes beyond its control. The customer shall not be relieved of his or her responsibility because of delays.

WORKMANSHIP

All work will be performed in a professional manner by experienced personnel outfitted with the appropriate tools and equipment to complete the work properly. Unless otherwise indicated herein, Tree Tech, Inc. will remove wood, brush and debris incidental to the work performed.

INSURANCE

Tree Tech, Inc. is insured for liability resulting from property damage and personal injury. All of Tree Tech, Inc. employees are covered by Workers Compensation Insurance.

OWNERSHIP

The customer warrants that all trees, plant material and property upon which the work is performed are either owned by him or her or that permission for the work has been obtained from the tree owner. Tree Tech, Inc. is to be held harmless from all claims for damages resulting from the customers failure to obtain this permission.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

All accounts are net payable upon receipt of an invoice. A service charge of 1 ½ % per month, which is an annual percentage rate of 18%, will be added to accounts thirty days after invoice date. If outside assistance is used to collect the account, the customer is responsible for all costs associated with the collection, including but not limited to attorney and court fees.

PERMITS

The customer shall pay for all required permits.

PROPERTY LINES - RESTRICTIONS

The customer shall indicate to Tree Tech, Inc. the corners of the property and shall assume all responsibility for the accuracy of markers. The customer shall give a copy to Tree Tech, Inc. any restrictions, easements or rights of way prior to commencement.

CONCEALED UTILITIES

The customer represents that he or she has no knowledge of any concealed utilities other than those, if any, set forth on the face page of this agreement as a special mark.

ACCESS TO WORK

The customer shall provide open access to work areas for Tree Tech, Inc. including employees, vehicles and equipment and agrees to keep driveways clear and available for movement and the parking of required trucks and equipment during normal working hours. Tree Tech, Inc's. Employees shall not be expected to keep gates closed for animals or children.

CONCEALED CONTINGENCIES

The customer agrees to pay Tree Tech, Inc. on a time and materials basis for any additional work required to complete the job occasioned by concrete, or any other foreign matter, stinging insect, rock, pipe or electrical lines encountered in excavations and not detected on the face of the agreement or any other condition not apparent in estimating the work specified.

PLANT HEALTH CARE APPLICATIONS

Tree Tech, Inc. will be responsible for the proper application of products commonly used in the business to help manage a specific problem involving trees, shrubs or plants but will not be responsible for any unforeseen or abnormal reaction resulting from the application. The parties agree that in no instance may the customer seek damages in excess of the contract agreement price.

CONTINUOUS SERVICE

Our Plant Health Care (PHC) services are provided as a continuous service. We will continue to perform applications that will help you manage the specified insect, disease, mite, cultural or soil chemistry issue we have diagnosed. You have the ability to cancel these services at any time up to the point that they are performed.

STUMPS

Stumps will be cut to within approximately twelve (12") inches of ground level unless specified to the contrary within this work specification. Stump grinding is not included in this Agreement unless specifically specified in our contract specification.
