

Hingham Legal Boundary Descriptions

Hingham Precinct 1.

Hingham Precinct 5.

Hingham Precinct 7.

All of that portion of Plymouth County bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of the Weymouth/Hingham town line and the Rockland/Hingham town line, and proceeding northerly along the Weymouth/Hingham town line to Plymouth River, and proceeding easterly along Plymouth River to an unnamed tributary of Plymouth River, and proceeding southerly along the unnamed tributary to Plymouth River to Whiting St, and proceeding southerly along Whiting St to Cushing St, and proceeding northerly along Cushing St to Old County Rd, and proceeding southerly along Old County Rd to Heritage Rd, and proceeding easterly along Heritage Rd to Presidents Rd, and proceeding southerly along Presidents Rd to Grenadier Rd, and proceeding easterly along Grenadier Rd

to Main St, and proceeding southerly along Main St to Polk Rd, and proceeding easterly along Polk Rd to Palmers Ln, and proceeding southerly along Palmers Ln to Scotland St, and proceeding easterly along Scotland St to Richard Rd, and proceeding easterly along Richard Rd to the intersection of the easterly projected extension of Richard Rd and Accord Brook, and proceeding northerly along Accord Brook for distance of 687 feet, and proceeding northerly and easterly from this point to Wanders Dr, and proceeding easterly along Wanders Dr to Upland Dr, and proceeding easterly along Upland Dr to Prospect St, and proceeding southerly along Prospect St to the Norwell/Hingham town line, and proceeding westerly along the Norwell/Hingham town line to the Rockland/Hingham town line, and proceeding westerly along the Rockland/Hingham town line to the point of beginning.
